

FOREX RIPPER

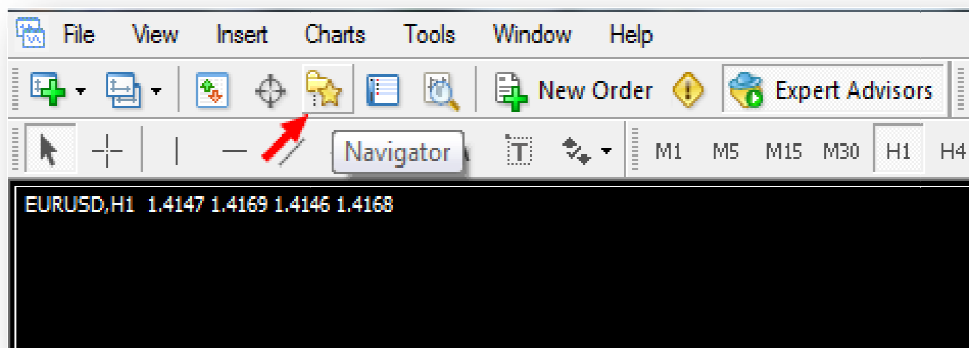
INSTALLATION

**To install the EA. Copy/Paste the ex4 file – Forex Ripper EA – to :
Windows/Program Files/Metatrader/Experts.**

Restart Metatrader.

Open EUR/USD chart.

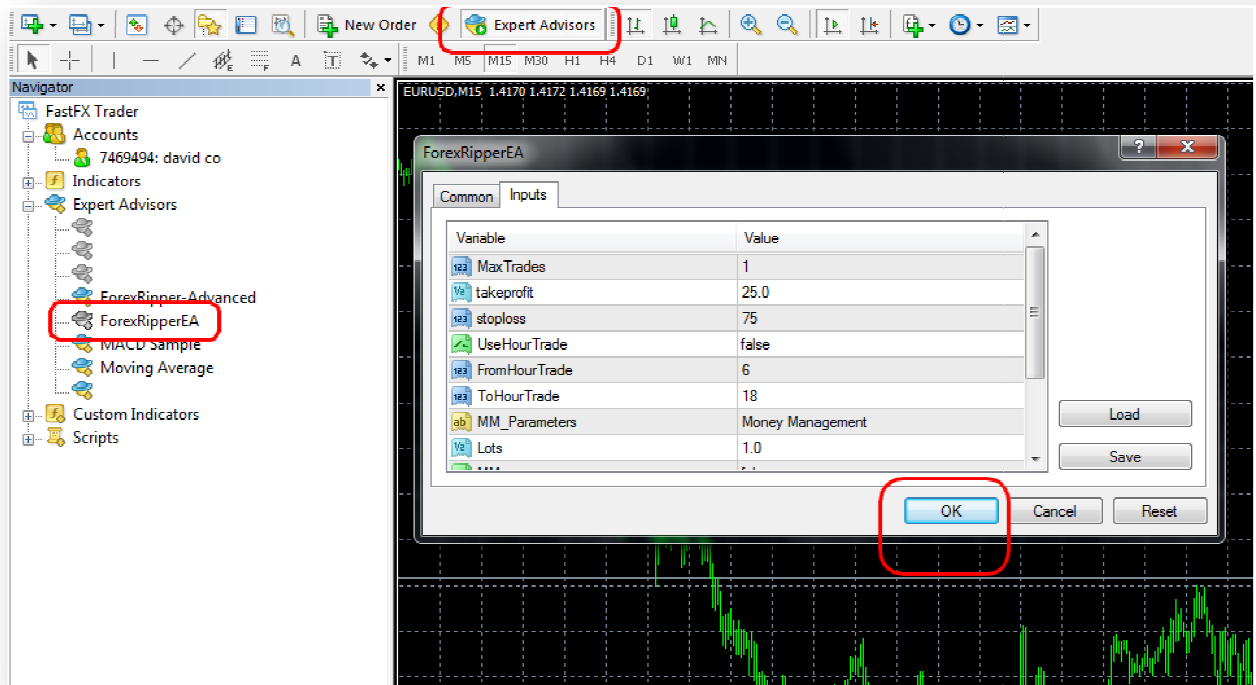
From the main toolbar, click on “Navigator” button.



A new window will appear on the left side of your screen. In the drop down list click on “Expert Advisors”.

Change time frame from 1 hour to 15 minutes then click on the icon “Forex Ripper”.

A popup window will appear on your screen with EA settings and parameters. Click OK.



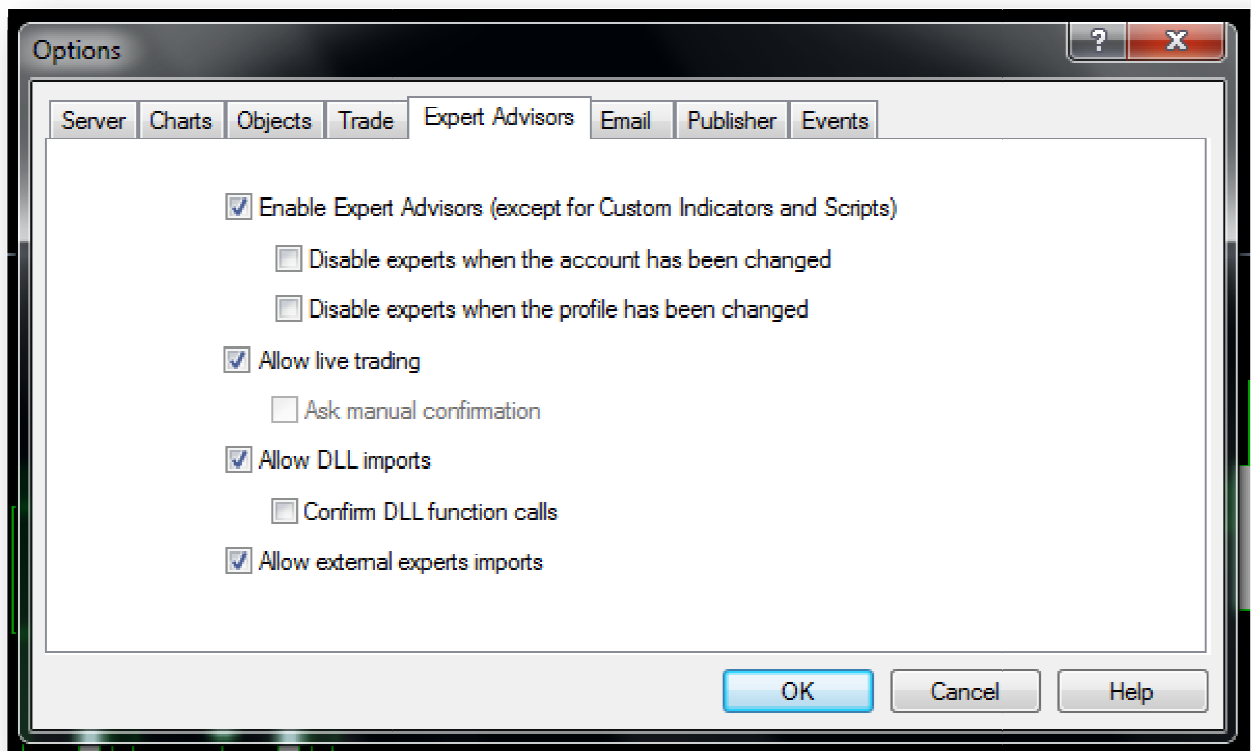
Make sure that the “Expert Advisor” button is active and showing a green light.

Now you should see a smiley face in the upper right corner of the chart. That means Forex Ripper is successfully installed.

PARAMETERS

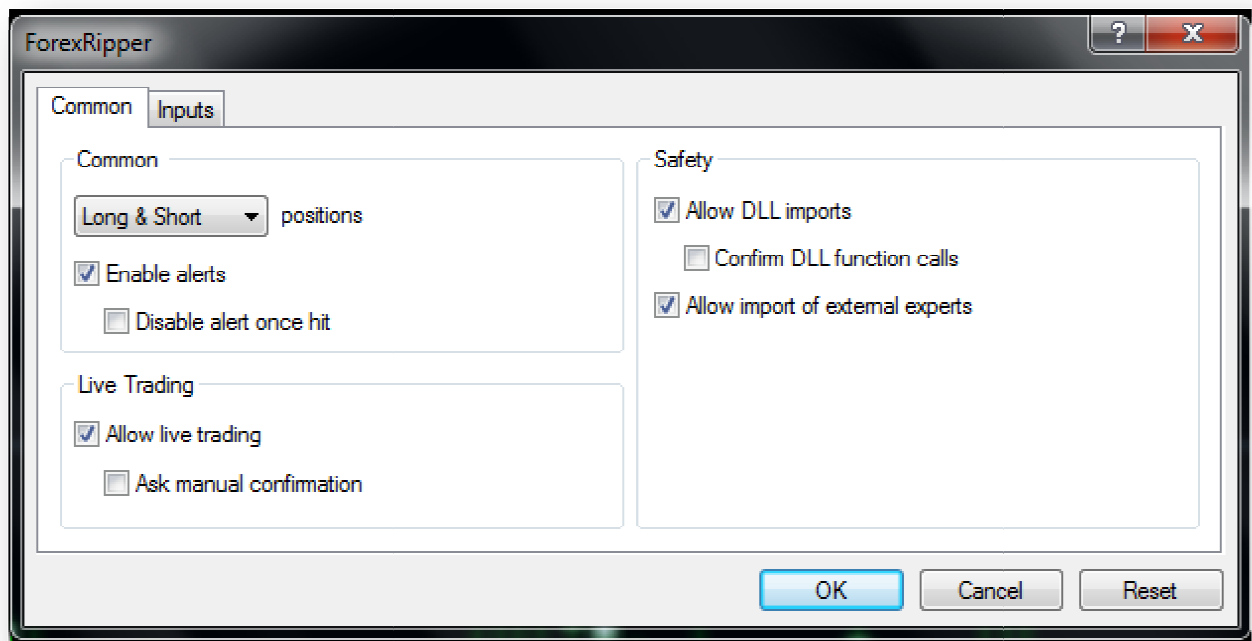
Before you can use the EA. Make sure that Metatrader's parameters allow the EA to trade.

Go to : Tools >> Options >> EXPERTS ADVISORS. And copy the settings below ..



Then click OK

**Right click on the chart, then choose Expert Advisors >> Properties.
And copy the settings below..**



Then Click OK

SETTINGS

Buttons: Load, Save, OK, Cancel, Reset

MAX TRADES : Maximum number of trades at the same time. Default is 1

TakeProfit : Take profit value – target – in pips. Default is 25 pips

StopLoss : Stop loss value in pips. Default is 75 pips.

UseHourTrade : False = EA works 24/5 - TRUE = EA works specific hours

FromHourTrade : Start working hours. Default is 6

ToHourTrade : End working hours. Default is 18

The above working hours are adjusted to GMT + 2

You need to change it according to your own broker's GMT offset settings. Ask THEIR support about that or compare their market watch to current GMT time.

For example, if their GMT offset is +1

Then start working hour should be 5 and end working hour should be 17.

If you don't know how to set this option correctly, then please simply turn it OFF

Lots : Number of lots to be used per trade. If Auto management is OFF

MM: Auto money management system. True = On - False = OFF

MicroAccount : if your account is a micro account set this option to TRUE

Risk : Risk % per trade – When auto money management is turned ON

MAGIC : Magic number. Change this number with any random number if you are using the EA on different charts at the same time

IMPORTANT

The EA doesn't work with : New NFA rules – ECN brokers.

If you are using a 5 digits broker. ADD 0 to take profit and stop loss values.

The EA needs to work 24/5 so you will need to leave the computer on or get a VPS service.

BEST PAIR = EUR/USD

BEST TIME FRAME = 15M

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
